To remove the old glass the brass boiler backplate has to be taken off. On a ready made loco (SL1,2 & 3) the pop rivets will have to be drilled out taking care not to enlarge the hole - particularly in the boiler.

To refit it is recommended that the pop rivets are replaced with 6 BA brass cheese or round head screws. These should be soft soldered with the heads inside the boiler, the solder forming a water seal as well as retaining the screw. Then re-assemble using a nut & washer taking care not to overtighten.


On a kit built loco simply unscrew the backplate retaining screws and change the glass and 'O' ring seal.


