MAMOD STRETCHING

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Being a modeller of limited means I cannot afford to buy steam engines at £250 plus a time, so I turned to the good old Mamod. I have done two simple convertions of these engines so far, and the results to my eyes are pretty and business like. Overleaf are the plans of the two convertions, each took about 3 hours, using simple tools and 'kitchen sink' modelling. First remove the cab back and rear buffer beam, cut main frame with a small hacksaw as shown, cut tags off and leave the floor flat, don't worry the new cab floor will act as a stiffener. The drawings (hopefully) are self-explanatory. Please excuse me calling aluminium 'ally', but it takes up less space on the drawings!
